Players Code of Conduct

All Grosvenor Hockey Club players agree to :

- Respect coaches, umpires and each other, both on and off the pitch
- Appreciate and support coaches, umpires, team captain and vice captain
- Respect the decision of the team selection panel whilst being free to seek an explanation
- Respect the decisions of and follow the instructions of a team captain and/or vice captain during matches, when no coach is present
- Arrive punctually for training sessions
- Inform the coach, team or vice captain, in advance, if you cannot attend training on a weekly basis
- Pay attention to coaches during training sessions
- Take responsibility for contributing to training and mileage costs
- Abide by the players code of conduct rules for the Ulster Womens Hockey Union
- Demonstrate proper personal behaviour and conduct at all times, for example, no swearing etc
- Minimise the risk to other players through your own conduct
- Ensure you wear proper safety equipment, for example, gum shields, shin pads etc
- Respect the facilities and equipment of CIYMS and other club's facilities, when playing at home or away
